

A Message from the Chancellor

Vision

- We aspire to be among the top 10 percent of American medical schools in health sciences education. To cite just a few yardsticks measuring our success thus far, our medical students have consistently achieved MCAT scores higher than the national average over the past 15 years; 60 percent of our graduates are accepted to their first choice of residencies; and U.S. News & World Report ranks UMass among the top 10 primary care medical schools in each of the past four years. A new grant from the Macy Foundation recognizes our leadership in the crucial area of teaching new physicians to communicate with patients.
- We aspire to be among the top 25 research institutions nationally. That means stepping up our growth in research funding, and we have been doing so: in the past three years, we ranked #2 among all 125 medical schools, in rate of growth. Some of the new programs that will help propel us into the top 25 are described in this annual report, beginning on page 4. This emphasis on growth is not because "bigger is better," but because our goals are ambitious. Our emphasis is ultimately on the quality of the work we do and the minds we attract and shape; so to increase the impact we have on the health of the nation, we know we must grow.
- We aspire to work in collaboration with UMass Memorial Health Care to become an academic health center of national

- distinction, building on a foundation of visibility developed through our faculty members whose clinical work is regularly recognized in the national news media, as well as in peer publications.
- We aspire to be a major asset to the City of Worcester and central Massachusetts in the areas of economic growth and K-12 science education. Building on community service exemplified by our leadership in the United Way and countless other endeavors, and on public education outreach such as the Worcester Pipeline Collaborative in science education, we will strive to continue earning the community support that sustains us.
- We aspire to be a national model in caring for Massachusetts' citizens and in serving its agencies. The needs are great, and already we have made remarkable progress in the realms of Medicaid, mental health, social services, public safety and public health.
- We are committed to working collaboratively with the entire University system to achieve our shared goals. Here, too, we will build upon strong programs already in place, such as Commercial Ventures and Intellectual Property, nursing education, adoption research and policy, and preventive medicine research. # Advancing patient care through research

alk to leading researchers at the University of Massachusetts Medical School and a common theme soon emerges: there are certainly better known and much older universities conducting health sciences research, but UMass Worcester is where the future of patient applications is "at."

That's why the nation's best and brightest investigators are increasingly choosing UMass Medical School to conduct their studies. They see exciting advancements happening here that are causing the nation and the world to take notice, and they want to be a part of it. They also witness top-notch personnel and state-of-the-art equipment and facilities being put into place here, ensuring that exciting things will continue to happen well into the next millennium.

Charles Vacanti, MD, Leslie Berg, PhD, Marc Fisher, MD, and Celia Schiffer, PhD, are among the promising researchers poised to make UMass Medical School a national household name. Their enterprising work in tissue engineering, drug design, neurodiagnostics and structural biology is setting an ambitious new pace for health sciences discovery.

### Charles Vacanti, MD

### Professor and Chair of Anesthesiology

Far be it for an anesthesiologist to bioengineer human tissue, but Charles Vacanti, MD, wasn't featured in *Life* magazine last August for being ordinary.

The professor and chair of anesthesiology first attracted worldwide attention three years ago when he grew cartilage in the shape of a human ear on the back of a mouse. Using polymers as frameworks and then seeding them with cells, or applying "tissue paint" to body organs and cavities, he has since grown tracheas, ligaments, tendons and bone. The possibility of regenerating and replacing diseased or damaged organs is now much closer to reality.

More recently, Dr. Vacanti took cells from a man who lost the end of his thumb in an industrial accident, grew them in a gel, and then injected them into a piece of coral, sculpted in the shape of the thumb bone. In a procedure performed by John Shufflebarger, MD, assistant professor of surgery, the coral was implanted in the patient's thumb. Living bone has since grown back and, pending Federal Drug Administration approval, Vacanti next hopes to grow cartilage to attach to the bone, restoring the patient's thumb to full use.


Vacanti also is now working collaboratively with his brothers, Martin Vacanti, MD, assistant professor of anesthesiology at UMass Medical School, and Joseph Vacanti, MD, professor of surgery at Harvard University and Massachusetts General Hospital — dubbed the "Wright brothers of tissue engineering" by *Life* magazine — to grow replacement spinal cords. The novel approach involves excising damaged spinal cord segments and replacing them with immature stem cells, which then grow into healthy replacement tissue.

Having already achieved "exceptionally good results" in the laboratory, Vacanti says "we're on the verge of being able to repair spinal cord damage or defects in humans."

All of this is made possible by the collaborative efforts between researchers of UMass Medical School and clinical partners at UMass Memorial Health Care. "We have superb people in various research endeavors that mesh together very well," notes Vacanti, "and we are tied to an excellent medical center that enables clinical application of our basic research.

"At UMass, there is active encouragement and opportunities to explore new areas. It is an institution that is on the cutting edge, and is willing to take novel approaches to make exciting new advances."

### Leslie Berg, PhD

### Associate Professor of Pathology

Leslie Berg left a prestigious post at Harvard University to become associate professor of pathology at UMass Medical School last year. She admittedly misses the cafes of Cambridge but, lab-wise, she hasn't looked back.

"It's unusual in my experience for a medical school or university to put so much of its resources back into research," says Berg. "I had this sense from looking at the dynamic people and research going on here that UMass is very committed to discovery."

Case in point: Berg says it took only a few meetings and a couple of letters before she and another recent arrival, Stephen Jones, PhD, were up and running with their new Transgenic/Knockout Mouse Core Facility (it essentially alters genes in mice to determine genetic functions). Besides the purchase and installation of major new equipment, it takes considerable time to train personnel to operate it, notes Berg. "Steve and I were both very impressed with the ease and speed with which we had resources to accomplish our goal," she says.

Berg's lab is ultimately seeking ways to combat HIV, the virus that causes AIDS; specifically, she is studying immune system T-cells that are designed to fight infection. "People with HIV don't actually die from the virus," explains Berg. "The problem comes from its special capacity to destroy your immune system T-cells, and you end up dying of other opportunistic infections," such as pneumonia.

By learning how T-cells develop, and what proteins are involved and how they're regulated, "one could actually try to control the process better."


Additionally, Berg's investigations could lead to improved acceptance rates of organ transplants. Often initially successful, transplants can ultimately fail when the patient's immune system identifies the donor organ as foreign and attacks it.

Immunosuppressive drugs have been developed to prevent the immune system from attacking donor organs, but they are not target-specific and inhibit the production of proteins that are present in many types of cells throughout the body. People taking them long-term can experience devastating side effects, such as kidney and liver failure, as a result.

Berg's investigations of immune system T-cells are not only useful for the development of better organ transplant drugs, but also may help to fight fatal autoimmune diseases, in which malfunctioning T-cells attack healthy tissue. "If you understand why an autoimmune disease happens or what triggers it," says Berg, "then you know what to target to try to stop it."

### Marc Fisher, MD

### Professor and Vice Chair of Neurology

Sitting in his laboratory surrounded by three-dimensional images of the brain, Marc Fisher, MD, feels at home. Here, in the magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) laboratory in Worcester's Biotech Park, the lion's share of Fisher's groundbreaking research occurs. The professor and vice chair of neurology is recognized internationally for his expertise in the field of stroke. Along with research partner Christopher Sotak, PhD, professor of biomedical engineering at Worcester Polytechnic Institute, Fisher has made significant advances in the early evaluation of acute stroke patients.


"We're studying the use of two innovative MRI techniques — diffusion-weighted imaging (DWI) and perfusion imaging (PI) — that provide intricate images of the patient's neurological condition just after stroke," says Fisher. "Both methods hold great promise, helping physicians manage patients during the critical hours after a stroke," he adds.

Diffusion-weighted imaging utilizes MRI technology to pinpoint the exact location of blood loss in the brain after stroke. Currently, computerized tomography (CT), the most widely used brain-imaging technique in stroke patients, is not always able to discern the location or extent of blood clots. Similarly, perfusion imaging, used in concert with DWI, measures the volume of blood flow to the brain, enabling doctors to predict shortvs, long-term brain injury.

In research circles, Fisher's work has evolved swiftly from the laboratory setting to the stroke patient's bedside with the introduction of clinical studies in hospitals across the country. In addition, his collaborations with the pharmaceutical industry are prompting the development of new drugs that dissolve blood clots in the brain.

Thought by many to be a visionary, Fisher talks of creating a dedicated Stroke Care unit to treat patients immediately after stroke. With baby boomers living longer, on average, in the years to come, he predicts an alarming increase in the incidence of stroke.

Fisher also dreams of the day when he can bring this specialized type of care to affiliate hospitals using telemedicine. "During the critical first hours after stroke, patients are better cared for in their own local hospital," says Fisher. "What we can provide is collaboration and consultation to fellow community radiologists and neurologists."



### Celia Schiffer, PhD

### Assistant Professor of Pharmacology

Less than a year ago, Celia Schiffer came to UMass Worcester from a postdoctoral position at Genentech, a South San Francisco-based biotech company specializing in anticancer drugs and human growth hormone products. What was the attraction? "There are a lot of young researchers here and a growing structural biology group working collaboratively to solve problems," says the assistant professor of pharmacology.

"I had a sense that UMass is really taking off and expanding quickly. So it seemed very exciting, people seemed excited to be here, and they interacted very well."

Co-funded by UMass Medical School and Marlborough pharmaceutical firm Sepracor, and supported by a team of three postdoctoral fellows and a staff assistant, Schiffer is zeroing in on the protease molecule contained in the HIV virus.

Demonstrates Schiffer on a computer model, "As the individual virus particles assemble, a series of their necessary components are attached to each other. For the virus particles to mature and become infectious, these necessary components must be cut apart. The protease is the 'scissors' molecule which 'knows' where to sever these components."

Drugs that target the protease have already been successfully developed to block the scissor action, thereby preventing the deadly virus from maturing and multiplying, notes Schiffer. Unfortunately, the virus is able to change, or mutate, so that the drugs no longer disable the scissor function. This altered virus is then "drug resistant" and able to attack and destroy the immune system.

"Our strategy is to examine how the protease 'knows' where to cut, and how this 'knowledge' is changed when the protease becomes drug resistant," explains Schiffer, who utilizes X-ray crystallography and enzyme kinetics to see molecules in atomic detail.

By revealing how the protease changes, Schiffer's data will complement the existing efforts of the pharmaceutical industry. "These combined efforts will, we hope, lead to the development of new protease inhibitors to treat AIDS patients who have drug resistant forms of the virus."

# ommunication as Curriculum

Future physicians learn to listen and be heard

Onsider these requirements for first-year medical students at UMass Medical School: biochemistry, anatomy, physiology, immunology — and communication. From the routine check-up to end-of-life care and every patient/physician interaction in between, communicating well has significant, lasting effects on patient satisfaction and medical outcomes, not to mention caregiver satisfaction. How physicians communicate is becoming as important to health care success as what they know.

Starting in 2002, medical students will have to demonstrate competency in communication to pass the National Board of Medical Examiners' licensure exam. As other medical schools rush to prepare their students, they may well turn for guidance to UMMS, already a recognized leader in teaching communication skills to health care providers.

In 1982, UMass Medical School required its new course in "Communication Skills" for first-year students. By 1992 it had evolved into the more comprehensive and focused "Medical Interview and Problem-solving" course. And with curriculum reform in 1995, communication skills were fully integrated into the teaching of clinical medicine in the "Patient, Physician & Society" course that is required for all first- and second-year students.

What was new and different 15 years ago is now fundamental, and UMMS continues at the forefront with both established and new initiatives to teach communication skills. The following profiles highlight three such efforts:





### Standardized Patient Program

In 1982, UMass Medical School's then curriculum dean Paula Stillman, MD, was already in the vanguard, using "standardized patients" to add hands-on instruction to the traditional books and lectures. Standardized patients are laypersons who are highly trained to simulate certain medical conditions in realistically staged "clinical" encounters. At UMass, they are also trained to evaluate and teach communication techniques which help a physician elicit information necessary for diagnosis and treatment, and establish trust and rapport with the patient.

Dr. Stillman introduced the communication component when she created the Master Interview Rating Scale (MIRS), an instrument that measures 20 specific communication skills. Today, the UMass Standardized Patient Program is still one of the few in the country to use the MIRS. The program's academic director, Wendy Gammon, MA, MEd, believes that this emphasis on communication is what sets the UMass program apart. "We give feedback," she says. After each simulation, the role-playing patient fills out the MIRS and discusses it with the student.

The UMass Standardized Patient Program has risen to prominence, providing services to other local medical schools, including Harvard, Dartmouth and Tufts, and serving as a model for academic centers throughout the world. UMass has also been chosen as a pilot test site for the National Medical Examining Board. While the board plans to establish 45 such test sites by the year 2002, so it can incorporate clinical simulations with Master Interview Rating Scales into the hitherto paper-and-pen-only exam, so far UMass is one of just 29 test sites nationwide. "They're finding their goal hard to meet because so few schools have what we have here," says Gammon.

### Helping Physicians to Communicate with their Patients

"We have a legacy of focusing on communication, and a dean who is a nationally renowned expert," says Mark Quirk, EdD, associate chair and professor of Family Health & Community Medicine, and assistant dean for academic achievement. He is modest about his own large role in establishing this legacy, beginning with the Communication Skills course he developed and launched with first-year students in 1982. This course was among the first in the country to use "acting" patients — the predecessors of today's Standardized Patient Program (see companion profile).

Most recently, Quirk has extended his expertise and vision to physician training.

"Fostering the Advancement of Clinical Communication Skills" (FACCS) is a continuing education seminar that covers "Basic Communication Skills and Patient Satisfaction" and "Difficult Patient/Provider Interactions." Each of two sessions features role playing and interactive discussion with standardized patients.

While primarily a patient satisfaction program initiated by the clinical system, FACCS builds a bridge between the academic enterprise and its clinical partner by helping faculty become better teachers. "This cyclical effect is a new model: what's good for patients is good for doctors is good for medical students and residents," says Quirk. "Everyone wants to improve communication."

And for good reason: the FACCS approach has a proven track record of achieving measurable results. After the Fallon Clinic invited him to do clinical training there, Quirk says, "We published the results in the Journal of the American Medical Association, demonstrating improved patient satisfaction and reductions in patient complaints that were maintained over a period of time." Outcomes are as positive for providers as for patients. Studies have shown that effective communication leads to improved patient compliance, fewer liability suits and, ultimately, improved medical outcomes.

### Macy Initiative in Health Communication

More than 30 years of research have documented the importance of effective communication in health care — but this body of knowledge has never been distilled into curricular content. Now, with the award of a major grant from the Josiah Macy Jr. Foundation, UMass Medical School, along with the New York University (NYU) and Case Western Reserve University (CWR) schools of medicine, is about to catapult communication skills into the mainstream of medical education.

The only project of its kind in the country, the Macy Initiative in Health Communication aims to enhance the communication skills of physicians through systematic training of medical students and house officers. Over the next four years, principal investigator Aaron Lazare, MD, chancellor and dean of UMMS, and investigators from NYU and CWR will work with their schools to create a curriculum and cultivate faculty who will pursue a distinct career path in health communications.

Unique to their approach will be organizing the existing body of knowledge into competencies that can be taught, evaluated and measured. "With limited time to conduct interviews and doctors pressured to see more patients, it is more important than ever that each interview be as efficient and effective as possible," says Dr. Lazare. Physicians will also reap personal rewards. "Communicating well with patients restores enjoyment and a sense of competency to doctors who are more and more under the gun."

Dr. Lazare and NYU's co-principal investigator Mack Lipkin, MD, are already recognized leaders in integrating communication skills into medical training. In 1995, they co-edited, along with Samuel M. Putnam, MD, "The Medical Interview," regarded as the definitive textbook on the subject. Says Lazare, "We're excited because, while there have been tremendous advances in research, findings have never been translated into teaching for practical clinical use. The hope is our three schools can spread the word and the excitement to the rest of the country."

One of the fastest growing academic health centers in the country, the University of Massachusetts Medical School has built a reputation as a world-class research institution, consistently producing noteworthy advances in clinical and basic research. This reputation is enhanced, according to Cheryl R. Scheid, PhD, vice chancellor for faculty administration, when endowed chairs are bestowed on its most distinguished faculty members.

"Receipt of an endowed chair establishes, in fact, that we are at the cutting edge of care, prevention and research in the particular discipline acknowledged," says Dr. Scheid. "It not only endorses the excellence of the institution, but also recognizes the research prowess of the individual who receives this title."

Scheid adds that the Medical School's receipt of such funding — made possible by the generous donations of benefactors — is particularly outstanding, since the misperception is that basic dollars are readily supplied for faculty at state universities and that there is little dependence on outside donations. It also allows UMMS a future opportunity to increase its research talent, recruiting faculty members from outside the institution who can contribute significantly to the success of the school's research initiative.

UMMS is dedicated to enhancing its program to designate endowed professorships and chairs. The school currently has 15 endowments, as well as an aggressive goal to add five more annually over the next several years. 

# **Turning** on to health sciences



Then scientists James Hamos, PhD, and Sandra Mayrand, PhD, began sharing their expertise in Shrewsbury classrooms, their approach was to simply provide children with hands-on science that was stimulating and fun. Five years and 13,000 students later, Hamos, director of the Office of Science Education (OSE), associate professor of cell biology and visiting professor at Worcester Polytechnic Institute, and Mayrand, associate director of the OSE, are applying that same successful formula to the region's K-12 science curriculum.

More than 500 UMass Medical School students, faculty and staff share their enthusiasm for science by visiting classrooms, inviting students and teachers into their laboratories and clinical sites, and leading teacher workshops through the OSE. With a budget of \$1.8 million, the office has tapped into some major funding sources, including a fiveyear grant from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and the Association of American Medical Colleges to create the Worcester Pipeline Collaborative.

The Pipeline strives to increase the number of students — particularly minorities and the economically disadvantaged — who pursue careers in health and science professions. This program fosters relationships with the Worcester Public Schools, higher education, and the local biotechnology industry.

"UMass represents the community's health care workforce. We hope that children understand that these occupations can be brought into their realm of possibility," says Hamos.

Another program showing the commonwealth's support of the OSE is the Central Massachusetts PALMS Collaborative, a regional provider that works with 78 school systems and the state's Department of Education to implement hands-on versus fact-based learning. Funded by the National Science Foundation through a State Systemic Initiative, PALMS provides districts and teachers with professional development, resources and technical assistance, and leadership training.

"I am proud of what we have accomplished," says Mayrand. "It is rewarding to see students become truly engaged in the joy and curiosity that is science."

### **National ranking**

Marianne E. Felice, MD, a nationally known figure in adolescent medicine with 25 years of experience in the field, joined the Medical School as chair of the Department of Pediatrics.

### **Biologic Labs director**

Donna M. Ambrosino, MD, a national leader in vaccine research and development, was appointed director of the Massachusetts Biologic Laboratories (MBL) at UMass Medical School's Jamaica Plain campus. Dr. Ambrosino was the first director named after the lab was transferred from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health to the Medical School in 1997.



### Soutter Library director

Elaine Russo Martin, MSLS, a pioneer of library automation and electronic access, was appointed director of the Lamar Soutter Library. She was formerly director for the Library for Health Sciences at the University of Illinois at Chicago.

### GSN establishes fund

The Graduate School of Nursing established an Education and Research Fund to enhance the GSN's research and education mission. The seed money provided by Dean Lillian Goodman, EdD, RN, professor of nursing, was augmented by contributions from members of the Class of 1998, the GSN Alumni Association, and friends.

### Clinical Care

### UMMHC board chair appointed

Robert S. Karam, CLU, ChFC, a Fall River business leader, was named chair of the UMass Memorial Health Care Board of Trustees. Karam also chairs the University of Massachusetts Board of Trustees.

### Community HealthLink affiliation

Community Healthlink, the region's largest provider of community mental health, substance abuse, homeless and rehabilitation services, serving 17,000 children and adults, formally affiliated with the Medical School's clinical partner, UMass Memorial Health Care, Under the affiliation agreement, Community Healthlink became the first subsidiary/affiliate of UMass Memorial Behavioral Health System, a non-profit subsidiary of UMMHC that was created in 1997.

### Tissue engineering

In a first-ever procedure that generated worldwide headlines, Charles A. Vacanti, MD, professor and chair of the Department of Anesthesiology, and John V. Shufflebarger, MD, assistant professor of surgery, used tissue that had been engineered in the laboratory from a patient's own bone cells to perform reconstructive surgery on the patient's severed thumb. The procedure marked the first time that tissue engineered in the lab was grafted into a human.

### Ob/Gyn appointments

Edward G. Peskin, MD, was appointed chief of the Division of General Obstetrics and Gynecology. His predecessor, Jeffrey O. Riley, MD, was promoted to the newly created position of vice chair of the Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology. Both Riley and Peskin are focusing on expanding obstetrical and gynecological services at UMMHC and on improving patient care and physician/patient communications.

### Bioengineered skin

In another first for central
Massachusetts, Raymond Dunn,
MD, associate professor of
surgery and a plastic surgeon at
UMMHC, used Apligraf™, a
living, bilayered skin construct
grown in the laboratory from
human skin cells, to treat the
chronic venous leg ulcers of three
patients. Apligraf™ is the first
such human body part to win
FDA approval.

### Cochlear implants

Cliff A. Megerian, MD, assistant professor of otolaryngology, director of otology & neurotology and co-director of the Skull Base Surgery Center at UMMHC, performed the region's first "bionic ear" implants to restore hearing for patients who were profoundly deaf. By combining computer technology, electronic circuitry and sound processing strategies, the implant transmits electrical signals directly to the auditory nerve, interpreted by the brain as sound.

### Telemedicine facility

William C. Meyers, MD, professor and chair of the Department of Surgery, received a \$1.4 million grant from the United States Surgical Corporation, the leading developer of surgical instruments, to fund a state-of-the-art telemedical facility for training both medical students and practicing physicians in endoscopic surgical techniques.

### Laparoscopic breakthrough

Surgeons at UMass Memorial Health Care eliminated a major obstacle to living-donor kidney transplantation when they removed a donor's kidney laparoscopically, through a tiny four-inch incision. The technique will reduce the usual four to eight weeks of recovery time to a mere two weeks, and the success of this pioneering procedure could make many more life-saving living-donor kidney transplants possible.

### Research

### Brudnick Neuropsychiatric Research Institute

Construction began on the Irving S. and Betty Brudnick Institute for Neuropsychiatric Research at UMass Medical School, a \$12 million, 32,000-square-foot research building. Named for the Brudnicks in recognition of their \$2.5 million gift in support of neuropsychiatric research, the facility is slated for completion in the fall of 1999.

### **UMass wins CFAR designation**

UMass Medical School was named one of 12 Centers for AIDS Research (CFAR) across the U.S. to share \$13 million in funding awarded by the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) and five other NIH Institutes. Mario Stevenson, PhD, professor of molecular genetics & microbiology, is director of the center and John Sullivan, MD, professor of pediatrics, pathology, and molecular genetics & microbiology, and director of pediatric immunology & rheumatology, is co-director.

### New infectious disease center

In response to the emergence of complex infectious disease strains worldwide, the Medical School recently launched the Center for Infectious Disease and Vaccine Research (CIDVR). It studies how the immune system reacts with pathogens to cause disease, and how it can be manipulated to prevent disease. Francis Ennis, MD, professor of medicine and molecular genetics & microbiology, is director and Alan L. Rothman, MD, associate professor of medicine and molecular genetics & microbiology, is co-director of the center.

### Mind-body medicine


In a study showing that psoriasis patients who practiced meditation-based relaxation while undergoing ultraviolet light treatments healed more quickly than patients who did not use meditation, Jon Kabat-Zinn, PhD, associate professor of medicine and executive director of the Center for Mindfulness in Medicine, Health Care, and Society, and his colleagues demonstrated that the mind can indeed influence an observable healing process.

### **Antibiotics grant**

Neal C. Brown, DVM, PhD, professor of pharmacology & molecular toxicology, won a \$100,000 federal Small Business Technology Transfer grant in conjunction with GLSynthesis Inc., a chemical synthesis company in Shrewsbury, to develop technology for a new class of antibiotics. The new drug compounds have been shown to block an enzyme essential for the survival of bacteria and may eventually be used to treat diseases including meningitis, pneumonia, ear infections, and urinary tract infections.

### **DNA** vaccines licensed

UMass Medical School has licensed exclusive, worldwide rights to Braasch Biotech Inc., a South Dakota biotech company, for the development of DNA vaccine technology to prevent rotavirus infections in animals. The patent, issued in May 1997 to UMass and John E. Herrmann, PhD, professor of molecular genetics & microbiology, is the first-ever DNA vaccine patent issued for a specific infectious agent.



### **Breast cancer studies**

Two breast cancer researchers at UMass received funding from the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation. William F. Greenlee, PhD, professor and chair of pharmacology, is studying a gene identified by his laboratory that represents an important new target for the diagnosis and treatment of breast cancer. Jane Teas, PhD, assistant professor of medicine, is studying the use of seaweed to help prevent breast cancer. Japanese women, who eat large quantities of seaweed, have a dramatically lower incidence of breast cancer than American women. Teas has also found that seaweed prevents breast cancer in rats.

# Impact of homelessness documented

In a landmark study published in the journal *Pediatrics*, Linda Weinreb, MD, associate professor of family medicine & community health, highlighted the health consequences of poverty and the added burden of residential instability that affects homeless children. The study presented clear evidence that homelessness is an independent predictor of poor health status in children, despite high use of medical services.

### Worcester Foundation trustees elected

Five new trustees were elected to the board of the Worcester Foundation for Biomedical Research: retired Vice Chancellor for Research Edward Bresnick, PhD; Melvin S. Cutler, founder of Flagship Bank and Trust of Worcester; I. Robert Freelander, founder and chair of Come Play Products; Maurice H. Martel, DDS, a clinical professor at the Tufts University School of Dental Medicine; and Robert M. Quinlan, MD, a former chair of the board of the Worcester Foundation and the incoming president of the Massachusetts Chapter of the American College of Physicians.

### Public Service

### **Breast Cancer Resource Guide**

The "Breast Cancer Resource Guide of Massachusetts," a comprehensive guide designed to help people diagnosed with breast cancer, was published to immediate demand. The brainchild of Karleen R. Habin, RN, clinical coordinator of the Center for Women's Health and a cancer survivor, the guide was produced through a two-year public-private partnership among UMass, the American Cancer Society, and the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and was funded through private foundations, pharmaceutical companies and individuals.



### Health Policy & Health Services Research Center

UMass Medical School established the Center for Health Policy & Health Services Research, a coordinating and collaborative clearinghouse for the growing research and policy work being done at the school. Jay S. Himmelstein, MD, MPH, professor of family medicine & community health, is the first director of the center. The center acts as a resource for health policy makers in the commonwealth, while working with such UMass initiatives as the Meyers Primary Care Institute (a joint venture with Fallon Health System); the Center for Outcomes Research in the Department of Surgery; and the Prevention Institute.

### MassHealth program

In a collaborative effort with the Massachusetts Division of Medical Assistance, UMass Medical School has organized and established the Center for MassHealth Evaluation and Research. The Center is designed to enhance the evaluation and research capabilities of the DMA in support of improving consumer service and health outcomes for MassHealth beneficiaries, while effectively managing costs for the commonwealth.

### **Worcester Pipeline**

The Worcester Pipeline Collaborative, led by Deborah Harmon Hines, PhD, associate vice chancellor for school services and professor of cell biology, and James E. Hamos, PhD, associate professor of cell biology and director of UMass' Office of Science Education, received a \$50,000 BankBoston Career Connection grant from the BankBoston Charitable Foundation. The gift will help purchase video and computer equipment to link the Pipeline Collaborative's teaching laboratory to science classrooms throughout the region.

### Serving the underserved

Students and faculty of the School of Medicine and the Graduate School of Nursing have teamed to provide free medical services to citizens lacking health care coverage. Located at the Epworth United Methodist Church in Worcester, the multi-discipline clinic is run by Paul Hart, MD, associate in Family Medicine & Community Health, with student supervisory assistance by Mary K. Alexander, EdD, associate dean of the GSN and professor, and Patricia Navin, EdD, assistant professor of nursing.

### Carballo Award

Thomas D. Manning, vice chancellor for Operations and Commonwealth Medicine at UMass Medical School, was one of 10 state employees to win the 1998 Manuel Carballo Governor's Award for Excellence in Public Service.



### Mort Sigel honored

Morton H. Sigel, chair of the board of trustees of the Worcester Foundation for Biomedical Research, was awarded the ninth Hudson Hoagland Award in recognition of his leadership of the institution. Sigel has been chair of the board since 1996, and presided over the talks that led to the merger of the Foundation with the Medical School in 1997.

### Facilities

### Shrewsbury campus new uses

The former campus of the Worcester Foundation for Biomedical Research - including nine major buildings on 80 acres providing wet lab, dry lab, office, conference, training, and animal facilities space - now houses several key UMass programs. These are the Center for Health Policy & Health Services Research, the Continuing Education Department, the Center for International Health Professions Education, the Standardized Patient Training Program, and the Department of Medical Assistance. Future plans for this prime property include expansion of funded wet lab research programs as well as incubator space for wet and dry lab research programs, office space and collaborative research ventures with biotechnology firms.

### **Acquisition of One Biotech**

UMass Medical School purchased One Biotech, a three-level building with 13,000 square feet of wet lab, dry lab, and office space, to house multiple programs including Commercial Ventures and Intellectual Property, the Center for Adoption Research, Correctional Medicine, and Commonwealth Medicine Business Services. Design is underway to renovate the second floor and a portion of the third floor to support the relocation of the UMass Memorial clinical laboratories, while the third floor now houses UMMHC administrative offices.

### \$22 million energy savings

UMass Medical School entered into an energy conservation contract that is guaranteed to save the institution \$22 million over the next 10 years. Through the state's Division of Capital Asset Management "Shared Energy Program," NORESCO of Natick has designed significant energy-saving changes to the building systems, ranging from lighting and motor replacements to major equipment upgrades in the campus power plant and elsewhere in the 25-year-old infrastructure.





# Value of Research

Why do we need to support research in a public university and, specifically, why in Massachusetts, where we have so many significant private research universities? We must first ask ourselves: What is a public university system and how does it differ from private counterparts?

Both are in the business of gathering and disseminating knowledge. And, for both, the client is the student. But in the case of the public university, the client is also the taxpayer who is helping to subsidize the education of the student. Because of this, UMass Medical School and other state institutions have increasingly focused on economic development as an integral part of their mission. And economic development is really only an offshoot of research. We need to support research at UMass to maintain and expand the University's role in economic development.

What else differentiates a public from a private university? A public university is supposed to be affordable. Since cost is so critical in a public university, there is even more motivation to support research as a revenue-enhancing activity.

The other arguments are less frequently made, but I believe they are perhaps even more important. Namely, we need to support research to maintain and increase the intellectual quality of our universities. To embrace research is to allow our institutions to compete — to offer excellence along with affordability.

It will also be increasingly difficult to attract top faculty without research opportunities and the funds and the relationships with the private sector that research makes possible. Institutions that can reward quality and productivity will keep and attract the best faculty.


We need to integrate research activities more into the undergraduate curriculum, not less. Why? It will improve student learning, better delivering what a university is supposed to deliver. It will also give us a competitive advantage, as the nature of the university changes dramatically with the onset of distance learning. The new, virtual university will have many advantages, primarily cost and convenience. What will keep students coming to a shared physical setting? Something that you cannot get over a computer screen: collaboration, apprenticeships, mentoring. In other words, the integration of research and teaching.

I think that UMass Medical School is headed very much in the right direction. Great medical students want to be taught by individuals who are expanding medical knowledge, who are making breakthroughs and can share their excitement with their students. Success will breed more success, bringing better faculty who will do more research and attract more research dollars, all along drawing more and better qualified students.

University research is increasingly the R&D arm for industry. Having a public university in a position to attract and retain companies is a critical advantage, as we have seen here in Worcester. It is the public university that is really compelled by its mission to do so. And students will be attracted to programs that allow hands-on research and interaction with real companies that may have real jobs to offer graduates.

The universities that succeed are going to be those that carve out a particular area of excellence — a niche — that enables them to offer a real future to their graduates. These are the kinds of schools that really will integrate research and teaching. And these are also the kinds of schools that should be called public universities.
